1. WHAT IS DISCIPLE NOW?

Disciple Now is a weekend specifically intended to disciple students. This year we will be staying at Mount Lebanon Cedar Hill, TX. At Mount Lebanon, the students will spend the night in lodges that we have rented out. We will have 2 lodges total; one for guys and one for girls. Within each of the lodges, there are two separate bunkrooms. So, we'll divide up Junior High boys from High School boys and Junior High girls from High School girls within the two lodges. Also, adults will be staying with the students in these lodges and leading small groups throughout the weekend. On Friday night, Saturday morning, and Saturday night, students will attend a large group worship service. After this, they will break off into age/gender specific small groups. While discipleship is the main goal of DNOW, we do try and plan some fun activities that will help students build good, Christ-centered relationships.

Basically, we are inviting the parents to stick around for a little while when they drop their child off. We'll have some desserts, coffee, and hot chocolate for you. After a time of fellowship and dessert eating, we'll give the parents of the students the opportunity to prayer over their student for the weekend. After this, parents are invited to join us for the first large group worship service or they can head on home. We're pumped about family prayer! This will give you the opportunity to get to know us and us to get to know you!
